Ermenegildo Zegna Vellus Aureum Trophy COMPETITION RULES 2024

1. CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Fleeces will be submitted for judging only if the Conditions of Entry have been met and approved.

- This competition is open to Australian wool growers.
- All entrants must be Superfine Merino ewe or whether skirted fleeces, no ram fleeces are accepted. Fleeces must be shorn in the current 2023 shearing season.
- \bullet All entrants must have a minimum weight of 750 grs. and must be tested 12,9 μ or finer.
- Participating farms must respect the IWTO's International Wool Textile Organization Wool Sheep Welfare Guidelines.
- Submitted fleeces must be from lots declared and documented NM under the National Wool Declaration.
- Zegna's ethical approach to animal welfare requires growers to follow the best practices: fleeces from sheep raised in single penning are not accepted and shedded sheep must have regular access to the paddock.
- The number of fleeces entered in the competition (maximum 10 per farm) must be declared in the Entry Form.
- The winning farms will have only one fleece each entering in the final ranking.
- All fleeces entered in the competition and accepted by the jury will be purchased by Ermenegildo Zegna at a price determined by the judges.

2. TIMING

• January 5th, 2024: Entry Forms to be sent to the coordinating companies (see indications in the Entry Form).

• January 5th, 2024: Fleeces to be delivered to the coordinating companies.

3. JUDGING AND SCORING METHOD

• The fleeces will be judged in accordance with the criteria listed below:

A) Micron and Weight 50 points
B) Style 20 points
C) Strength 15 points
D) Evenness 10 points
E) Excellence by Judge 5 points

Ermenegildo Zegna Vellus Aureum Trophy COMPETITION RULES 2024

- A) MICRON AND WEIGHT: 50 points in total, 40 for micron and 10 for weight. The evaluation of micron will be made with the OFDA system.
- B) STYLE: 20 points Subjective appraisal. Points will be awarded for style, crimp-evenness and consistency of definition, bloom, handle / softness.
- C) STRENGTH: 15 points Subjective appraisal. Judges will assess strength under the accepted code used for non-strength measured wools. (Sound=15 points, W1=8 points, W2=2 points, V = 0 points).
- D) EVENNESS: 10 points Subjective appraisal. To be judged on evenness of length / style / quality / appearance.
- E) EXCELLENCE: 5 points by judges' discretion.

4. PRIZES AND PRICE GIVING

- The five finalists will be announced and awarded in the first half of 2024.
- The winner will be awarded with a silver and gold plate and an amount of AU\$ 15.000.
- Classified 2nd and 3rd will receive each a silver plate, and the amount respectively of AU\$ 3.000 and AU\$ 1.500.
- Place getters 4th and 5th will receive each a silver plate.



Ermenegildo Zegna Superfine Wool Trophy COMPETITION RULES 2024

1. CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Samples of the wool lots will be submitted for judging only if the Conditions of Entry have been met and approved.

- Wool lots must come from the 2023 shearing season.
- Entrants must be merino wool lots 14.5 to 18.0 μ .
- Only one lot per farm, 1 to 5 bales maximum. Please indicate the size of the wool lot in the Entry Form.
- Participating farms must respect the IWTO's International Wool Textile Organization Wool Sheep Welfare Guidelines.
- Submitted lots must be declared and documented NM under the National Wool Declaration: copy of the NWD will have to be sent together with the Entry Form.

2. TIMING

- Participating farms must submit and send a sample of their lot to Australian Wool Network, 51 Finlay Rd., Goulburn NSW by January 5th, 2024.
- The jury will do a first assessment upon all the samples and will select the best 10 lots before the end of January 2024.
- Non finalists will be immediately notified to consider different selling alternatives.
- The 10 finalists will be asked to send their entire lots to their brokers within January 31st, 2024 and will be immediately paid.
- Top 10 lots will be moved into the same location (Australian Wool Network, 51 Finlay Rd., Goulburn NSW) for the final global evaluation and judging.
- Final judging will take place in February 2024.

3. JUDGINGAND SCORING METHOD

- The finalist wool lots will be judged by independent judges utilizing the full test results.
- Final judging will consider the parameters within the whole lot.
- Fineness will not be a scoring parameter, but among two lots achieving the same score, finer will prevail.
- $\bullet\,$ The lots will be judged in accordance with the criteria listed below:

A) Yield	10 points
B) Strength	20 points
C) Conformity of Length	20 points
D) Trueness to type	20 points
E) Evenness of quality	20 points
F) Excellence by judges	8 points
G) Number of bales premium	2 points

A) YELD: 80% = 10.0 points

68% = 6.0 points

B) STRENGHT: (points)

C) LENGTH: Length relative to tested fineness and evenness through the lot.

D) TYPE: Traditional style, handle, softness, and bloom, including VM (max. 1,5% eligible).

E) EVENESS: Through the lot and regularity in the staple.

F) EXCELLENCE: By judges' discretion.

G) PREMIUM for Nr. of bales (points):5bls= 2.0 4bls= 1.5 3bls= 1.0 2bls= 0.5

4. PRIZES AND PRICE GIVING

- The ten finalists will be announced in February 2024. They will be rewarded by Ermenegildo Zegna and their lots will be bought at the average market price of similar types sold between July 2023 and end January 2024, with a 50% premium.
- 1st, 2nd and 3rd place getters will be awarded with a silver plate and the amount respectively of AU\$ 7.500, AU\$ 3.000 and AU\$ 1.500. They will also receive 3 cut lengths of fabrics each, specifically produced by Ermenegildo Zegna Woolmill with the name of their property written in the woven selvedge.
- Place getters from the 4th till the 10th will receive each a silver plate.


