The competition aims to visualise the provenance and promote the excellence and dedication of ASWGA Members in the production and processing of their superfine Merino wool, achieving the highest quality standards enhancing this through the ASWGA Rams head™.

Rules of the Competition

THE COMPETITION

- The competition will be held annually.
- The style and content to be open to the photographers' choice and should relate to the following aims.
- The photograph should endorse and promote the positive attributes of Superfine Merino Wool production on farm, through shearing, clip preparation and subsequent processing through to retail.
- Consideration be given to reinforce best practice principles underpinning the ASWGA Rams head™
- The competition is open to financial ASWGA Members, their immediate family and employees.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- To be submitted for judging in digital or printed format of high resolution, the preferred minimum to be 5MB (megabytes)
- To be presented in either landscape or portrait print orientation.
- To be a single photograph.
- ASWGA will have the right to use any of the photographs entered in the competition for promotional purposes free of any charges. ASWGA will have copyright over the winning photograph and/or any poster derived from the photograph.
- ASWGA members may use the promotional material provided the photographer is recognised.

JUDGING - The judge's decision is final.

A Judging Panel will be appointed by the ASWGA to consist of at least 3 of the following:

- A Photographic Artist (preferably with known skill at judging photographic competitions).
- An ASWGA member who has an understanding of the aims and operations of ASWGA.
- Industry person

NOTIFICATION OF THE WINNER & THE PRIZE

- The winner will be announced in the 2023-24 ASWGA Annual and on the ASWGA Website.
- The competition commences on the 1 January 2023 and concludes on the 30 June 2023.
- All entries must be received at the office by 30 June 2023 to be eligible.
